

In compliance with federal regulations (34 CFR § 668.43), Northeastern University provides disclosures regarding professional licensure requirements for applicants and students enrolled in programs that may lead to such licensure. This informs applicants and students about whether their program meets licensure requirements in their home state or territory of residence.

- **Initial Determination of Residence**

- The student's residence location is initially determined by the home address listed on their admissions application.
- For international applicants (outside U.S. states or territories), the state or territory of the campus where they seek to be or are enrolled will be considered their location for licensure purposes.

- **Notification During Admissions**

- Applicants to licensure-track programs will be notified whether their chosen program meets licensure requirements for:
 - Their home state or territory (for domestic students).
 - The campus state (for international students).
- If the program does **not** meet licensure requirements for the student's home state or territory, students have two options:
 1. Apply to another program that does meet their home state or territory requirements.
 2. Acknowledge that the program does not meet their home state or territory's requirements and specify a state or territory they intend to move to after graduation where the program meets licensure standards by attesting to this when presented on the application or in the Application Status Check portal.

- **Address Updates for Enrolled Students**

- Once admitted, all students in licensure-track programs must update their local address via the Student Hub within 14 days of any address change.
- If a student changes residence to a new state or territory and has updated their address via the Student Hub as required, they will receive official notification via the Student Hub through the Registrar's office within 14 days

to inform them whether their program meets the licensure requirements in that new state or territory.
